What is Accreditation?

Accreditation:

The process in which a programme of study or institution is assessed for its standard and given official recognition. Two types of accreditation:

- Programme; and
- Institutional



Eligibility for Accreditation

- Based in Barbados
- Registered with the Council
- Have a Certificate of Incorporation to operate in Barbados
- Application for accreditation approved at the governance/management level
- Provide list of programmes/courses
- Have a sound financial base





Institution contacts Council requesting accreditation application form

Institution completes forms with required documentation attached (**including institution self study**) and returns to the Executive Director

The Council reviews the application form and reply to the institution

The **Council** sends Evaluation Team nominees to institution for endorsement

Institution gives endorsement of Evaluation Team

The **Council** and the **Institution** agrees on dates and timings for the Institutional Visit

Evaluation Visit

The Council sends report minus recommendations to institution

Institution responds to Executive Director on the factual accuracy of the Evaluation Report

Council informs institution of decision

Institution has the right to appeal unfavourable decisions



Accreditation Period

 Institutional Accreditation – 3, 5 or 7 years depending on the maturity of the provider;

Programmatic Accreditation – currently under consideration
